GRANT MAKING BUDGET

Ted told the board he would like to renew for another 3-year term as the Ripley County representative member.

CFO UPDATE

Affiliate Appreciation Conference will be held on April 25, 2022, in Springfield, MO. Registration is open now. This will be an in-person conference. Judy appreciates everyone updating their contact information with CFO and hopes everyone is now able to receive updates and other important correspondence from CFO. Judy mentions that Crystal and Lydia have met with several potential fund holders to establish new funds under OFRCF. Crystal mentions that last week there was a meeting with the city of Poplar Bluff's department leadership to discuss options available for them to establish funds. Since this meeting Crystal has receive interest from the animal shelter, Margaret Harwell Art Musem, and the City of Poplar Bluff City Museum for further information. Crystal also mentions a few weeks ago she held a meeting with Mary Haldeman of Foster Adopt Connect to discuss the opportunity to establish funds; she has not heard any additional information but will continue to propose this potential partnership.
